Emergency Supply Kit

- [] Water (1 gallon per person/day for 3 days)
- [] Non-perishable food (3-day supply)
- [] Battery-powered or hand-crank radio
- [] NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert
- [] Flashlight
- [] First aid kit
- [] Extra batteries
- [] Whistle to signal for help
- [] Dust mask
- [] Plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-inplace
- [] Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties
- [] Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- [] Can opener for food
- [] Local maps
- [] Cell phone with chargers and a backup battery

When Storm Is Coming

- [] Monitor weather updates
- [] Charge electronic devices
- [] Fill car's gas tank
- [] Bring outdoor objects inside
- [] Secure windows and doors
- [] Evacuate if ordered

Insurance & Backup

- [] Review insurance policies
- [] Document valuable possessions
- [] Back up electronic data

Family Emergency Plan

- [] Discuss hurricane risks with family
- [] Identify meeting place if separated
- [] Establish communication plan
- [] Review evacuation routes
- [] Plan for pets
- [] Store important documents in waterproof container

Home Preparation

- [] Reinforce doors and windows
- [] Trim trees and shrubs
- [] Clear gutters and downspouts
- [] Secure outdoor objects
- [] Know how to turn off utilities
- [] Consider buying a generator

During the Storm

- [] Stay indoors
- [] Avoid windows and doors
- [] Listen to weather updates
- [] If flooding occurs, go to higher ground

After the Storm

- [] Check for injuries
- [] Avoid downed power lines
- [] Do not drink flood water
- [] Inspect home for damage
- [] Take photos of damage for insurance claims
